Dear Potter Valley Families,

We are starting a review of our transportation in the hopes of being able to offer more opportunities for more families. In addition, we want to be proactive and have routes prepared to be used immediately when we have qualified applicants hired for the bus driver position. We will use the information to determine if we are able to add additional bus stops this year or in the 2022-2023 school year.

To begin this process, we are sending out this survey to help analyze the bus transportation to and from school. The questions address the constraints we will be working under to develop bus routes including but not limited to: location and safety of bus stops (example: 500' view is required in both directions when speed limit is greater than 25 mph), arrival and departure times, size of the bus, and length of bus ride for students. We appreciate your time in filling out the survey.

At this time, we have one bus route and one driver. We have been advertising since Fall 2018 for additional bus drivers. While our salaries are competitive and we provide paid training, like most districts across the country we are struggling to hire drivers. If you or someone you know is interested in bus driving, please contact the District Office. Please find attached to this letter a copy of the requirements to be a bus driver.
