The school is not able to accommodate additional visitors or co-trips with the school stay. We ask that families do not plan their own visits to the park that coincide with the school trip.

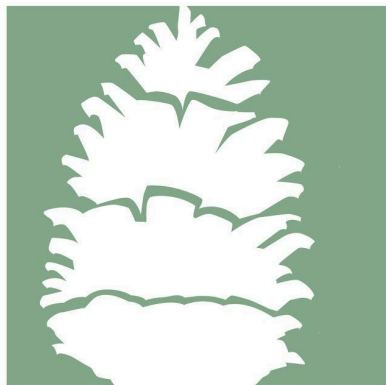
